



# PARTS OF SPEECH

## Noun

**A person, place, thing, or idea**

**Examples: cat, teacher, park, joy**

## Pronoun

**Takes the place of a noun**

**Examples: he, she, it, they, you**

## Verb

**An action or a state of being**

**Examples: run, jump, is, are**

## Adjective

**Describes a noun**

**Examples: blue, tall, happy, five**

## Adverb

**Describes a verb, adjective, or another adverb**

**Examples: quickly, very, softly, now**

## Preposition

**Shows relationship between a noun and another word**

**Examples: under, over, through, by, with**

## Conjunction

**Connects words or groups of words**

**Examples: and, but, or, because**

## Interjection

**Expresses strong feeling or emotion**

**Examples: wow! oh! ouch! yay!**
